New buildings provide state-of-the-art enhancements

Project Highlights

- Start date: Jan. 19, 2006
- Dedication ceremony: February 21, 2008
- Total square footage: 95,000
- Total number of buildings: 2
- Total project cost: \$34.4 million
- Building 600 (65,000 square feet) encompasses:
 - 80% classroom space
 - expanded Academic Support Center
 - Art Gallery
 - Cyber café
 - Five science laboratories
 - Simulated dental clinic/ Dental Hygiene Labs/Classrooms
 - Computer graphics studios
 - Art and Photography Studios
 - Six classrooms
 - Eight break-out rooms
 - Academic Resource Space
- Building 700 (30,000 square feet) houses:
 - Two-story library
 - Computer classrooms
 - Study space
 - Coffee/sandwich bar

Did you know?...

- DuBose Associates Architects designed interior elements of the 600 Building to resemble a river. Inspiration for the design was taken from "Tunxis," a Native American word that translates to "the bend in the river."
- Two miles of conduit and one and a half miles of caulk have been laid in the 600 and 700 Buildings.
- Governor M. Jodi Rell joined the Tunxis community for the ribbon cutting ceremony in Feb. 2008.
- Phase II of construction is on the horizon.
