



**Employment by Program of Study:**

- Of the 360 Tunxis Community College (TCC) graduates, 74% were employed in CT during the third quarter after graduation.
- The greatest number of employed graduates majored in Business Management & Administration (97).
- The rate of employed graduates by program of study ranged from a high of 86% for Security & Protective Services to a low of 56% for Visual & Performing Arts.
- 77% of employed graduates were women.
- About 51% of employed graduates worked in firms with 100 or more employees; 29% worked in firms with 500 or more employees.

### Employment and Earnings by Industry:

- About half (49%) of the TCC graduates employed in Connecticut during the third quarter after graduation were working in the Health Care & Social Assistance industry and Retail Trade sector.
- The overall average quarterly earnings for graduates employed in the third quarter after graduation was \$9,416. Graduates working in Manufacturing had the highest average quarterly earnings (\$16,232).
- Compared to overall statewide employment, a greater percentage of TCC graduates were employed in the Health Care & Social Assistance, Educational Services and Retail Trade sectors.

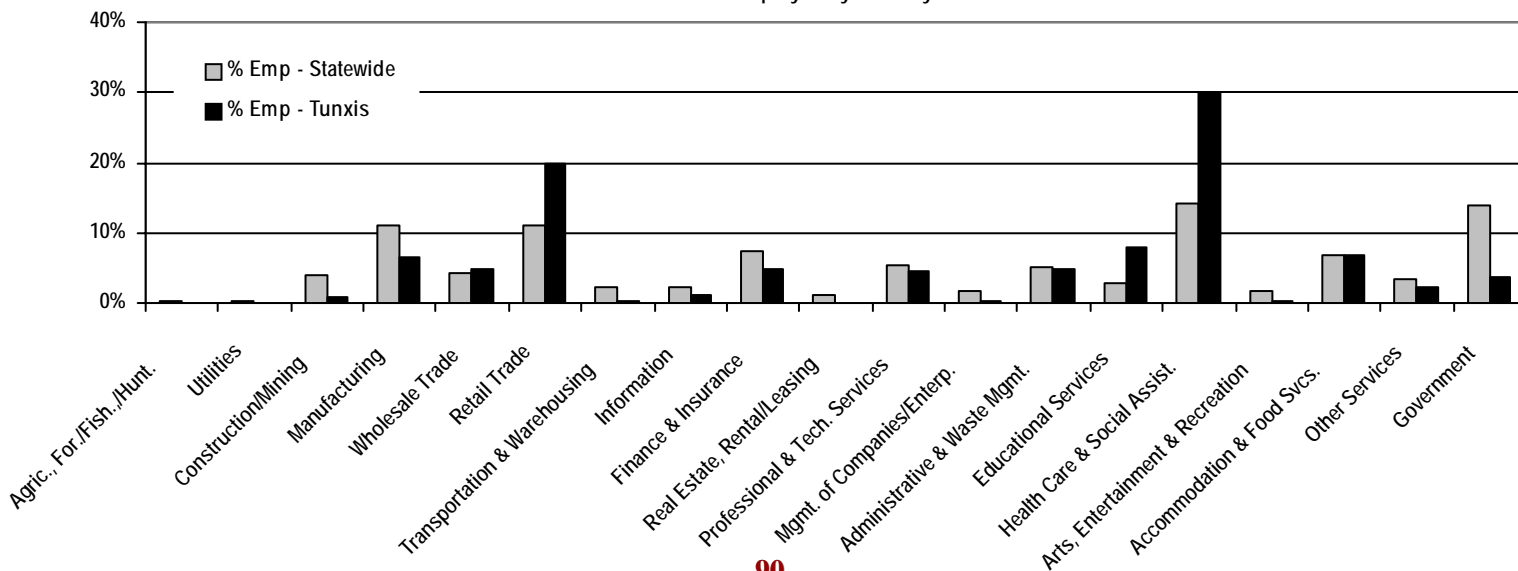

**Employment by Industry and Degree Program:**

- About 26% of the 57 TCC graduates who majored in Liberal Arts & Sciences and were employed in the third quarter after graduation were working in the Retail Trade sector.
- 84% of the 50 graduates who majored in Health Professions & Related Science and who were employed in the third quarter after graduation were working in the Health Care & Social Assistance sector.



**Employment and Gender:**

- Of the 266 TCC female graduates, 77% were employed in the third quarter after graduation; 65% of the 94 male graduates were employed.
- For both males and females, those who majored in Security & Protective Services had the higher employment rates (93% and 79%, respectively) in the third quarter after graduation.
- Approximately half (49%) of the 204 female and 61 male graduates employed during the third quarter after graduation were working in the Health Care & Social Assistance and Retail Trade sectors.
